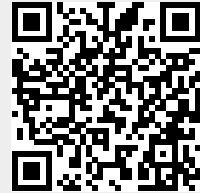

Motherboards on modern PCs are a general equivalent. It also distributes low-voltage AC and DC, filtered and unfiltered power to each slot
